FAIR RULES

- 1. Walk your horses at all times outside of makeup arena and arena.
- 2. No animals allowed on track or asphalt.
- 3. You must always ride with a bridle(no halters).
- 4. Treat others with respect and consideration, including adult committee leaders.
- 5. Helmets must be worn at all times you are riding.
- 6. Boots are required when riding. Closed toe shoes any time you are handling horses. NO FLIP FLOPS or SANDALS.
- 7. Only 4-H members are allowed to ride horses during fair week. No exceptions. This includes family members.
- 8. All Pets are required to stay at the campsite or day parking site and must be on a leash. No animals are allowed in the barn or around show arena. This is a safety issue and also a Fairboard rule!!

BARN RULES

- 1. No running in the barn.
- 2. NO riding in the barn.
- 3. Horses will ALWAYS have water. This includes non-show days!!!! If it is hot, 2 buckets are recommended.
- 4. Only feed your animal when instructed: Morning -7am Evening 5pm ** If you are unable to be there during this time, you must plan for someone to feed your animal for you. NO exceptions. Feeding your animal is important for the safety of your horse and others around your horse. Repeat warnings for not feeding at proper times may result in sending the horse home.
- 5. You must have a lead rope tied around your stall gate when your horse is in its stall.
- 6. Halter must be on your animal while in its stall.
- 7. Don't tack up in the aisleway, this leads to potential problems between horses and also too much congestion.
- 8. All stalls must have shavings in them. You must clean your stalls **TWICE** a day! NO shovels pitchforks only.
- 9. No smoking, chewing or alcoholic beverages allowed in the barn.
- 10. The barn will be closing at 10:30 each night. All horses must be in their stall and you must leave the barn by this time!!!
- 11. DO NOT LEAVE MANURE IN A BARN BUGGY!!!!! After cleaning your stall, you must dump your buggy whether it is full or not. Keeping the barn clean is important and is a representation of our club to those walking through the barn. If you need help emptying it, just ask for assistance.
- 12. Keep your tack stall and aisleway in front of your stall clean.

Barn Check-in/out Information

Check-in time for fair is **Sunday, July 11 from 3-6pm**. Once you arrive, we ask that you go to the check-in table FIRST before going to your stall. Your horse will need to have a body score check by the vet and you will be assigned your stall number.

Check-out time starts Friday, July 18 at 9am.
