Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established in memory of Benjamin Paul Konger. Ben was an active 10 year member of the Blazing Saddles 4-H Horse and Pony Club of Noble County. Up to two, \$500.00 scholarship may be awarded annually. A maximum of one scholarship may be awarded in the same academic year. Applications must be made by March 31st of each year and will be determined by July 1st of that same year.

Qualifications

Applicants must be active in the Blazing Saddles 4-H Horse and Pony club of Noble County. Scholarship will be given to applicants interested in any fields of study.

Awards

Awards will be considered on the basis of need, scholastic achievement, character, and their active participation in the Horse and Pony Club.

Awards will be paid directly to the educational institution and will be applied towards the student's tuition and fees.

If unable to complete the academic year for which the scholarship has been given, the award will be rescinded and it will be the responsibility of the recipient to return the award in full to the Benjamin Paul Konger Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Decisions made by the Benjamin Paul Konger Scholarship Committee will be final.
