Benjamin Paul Konger Memorial Scholarship



This scholarship fund was established in memory of Benjamin Paul Konger. Ben was an active 10-year member of the Blazing Saddles 4-H Horse and Pony Club of Noble County. Up to two \$500.00 scholarships may be awarded annually. A maximum of one scholarship may be awarded in the same academic year. Applications must be postmarked by May 31st of each year and will be determined by July 1st of that same year.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must be active in the Blazing Saddles 4-H Horse and Pony Club of Noble County. Scholarships will be given to applicants interested in any field of study including apprenticeships and trade schools in addition to traditional post-secondary education.

Awards will be paid directly to the applicant to be applied to the educational institution's tuition and fees or to trade schools for fees, tools etc.

If the applicant forgoes or is unable to complete the academic year for which the scholarship has been given, the award will be rescinded, and it is the responsibility of the recipient to return the award in full to the Benjamin Paul Konger Memorial Scholarship.

Decisions made by the Benjamin Paul Konger Scholarship Committee will be final.
